ORDER

G. O. (P) No. 48/2014/F&PD. Dated, Thiruvananthapuram, 13th June, 2014.

S. R. O. No. 354/2014.—WHEREAS, under sub-section (1) of section 33 of the Kerala Co-operative Societies Act, 1969 (21 of 1969), the term of an administrator or an administrative committee appointed to manage the affairs of a society shall not exceed one year in the aggregate;

AND WHEREAS, the said term of one year of the administrative committee appointed under sub-section (1) of section 33 of the said Act, to manage the affairs of the Chowara Fishermen Development Welfare Co-operative Society Ltd. No. D. F. (T) 7/92 in Thiruvananthapuram District expired on 25th April, 2013;

AND WHEREAS, under sub-section (1A) of section 33 of the said Act, the Government may, by notification in the Gazette, for reasons to be recorded, permit the Registrar of Co-operative Societies to extend the term of the said administrator or administrative committee for a further period not exceeding one year in the aggregate or till a newly elected committee enters upon office, whichever is earlier;

AND WHEREAS, the Government as per Notification issued under G. O. (P) 29/2014/F & PD dated 26th April, 2014 and published as S. R. O. No. 250/2014 in the Kerala Gazette Extraordinary No. 1088 dated 26th April, 2014 have permitted the Registrar of Co-operative Societies (Fisheries) to extend the term of the administrative committee of the said society for a period of one year from 26th April, 2013 to 25th April, 2014 and the term so extended also expired on 25th April, 2014;

AND WHEREAS, the Director of Fisheries who is also the Registrar of Co-operative Societies (Fisheries) has reported that the election to the Board of Directors of the said society could not be conducted within the extended period due to the paucity of funds in the society and has requested to appoint a new administrator for a period of six months from 26th April, 2014 to 25th October 2014 or till a newly elected committee enters upon office, whichever is earlier, to avoid administrative vacuum in the said society;

AND WHEREAS, the Government have considered the matter in detail and are satisfied that it is necessary in public interest, to direct that the provisions of sub-section (1A) of section 33 of the said Act shall apply to the said society with certain modifications and to permit the Registrar of Co-operative Societies (Fisheries) to appoint a new administrator to manage the affairs of the said society for a further period of six months from 26th April, 2014 to 25th October 2014 or till a newly elected committee enters upon office, whichever is earlier to avoid administrative vacuum in the said society;

NOW, THEREFORE, in exercise of the powers conferred by section 101 of the Kerala Co-operative Societies Act 1969 (21 of 1969), the Government of Kerala hereby direct that the provisions of sub-section (1A) of section 33 of the said Act shall apply to the Chowara Fishermen Development Co-operative Welfare Society Ltd. No. D. F. (T) 7/92 in Thiruvananthapuram District with the

modification of substituting the words "One and half year" for the words "One year" and in exercise of the powers under sub-section (1A) of section 33 of the said Act, as so modified, permit the Registrar of Co-operative Societies (Fisheries) to appoint a new administrator to manage the affairs of the said society for a further period of six months from 26th April, 2014 to 25th October, 2014 or till a newly elected committee enters upon office, whichever is earlier.

Explanatory Note

(This does not form part of the order, but is intended to indicate its general purport.)

The term of administrative committee appointed under sub-section (1) of section 33 of the Kerala Co-operative Societies Act, 1969 (21 of 1969), to manage the affairs of the Chowara Fishermen Development Welfare Co-operative Society Ltd. No. D. F. (T) 7/92 in Thiruvananthapuram District extended in pursuance of the notification issued under G. O. (P) 29/2014/F & PD dated 26th April, 2014 and published as S. R. O. No. 250/2014 in the Kerala Gazette Extraordinary No. 1088 dated 26th April, 2014 also expired on 25th April, 2014. The Registrar of Co-operative Societies (Fisheries) has reported that the administrative committee of the said society could not conduct election within the above said period due to paucity of funds and has requested to appoint a new administrator for a period of six months from 26th April, 2014 to 25th October 2014 or till a newly elected committee enters upon office, whichever is earlier to avoid administrative vacuum in the said society. The Government have considered the matter in detail and are satisfied that it is necessary in public interest, to direct that the provisions of sub-section (1A) of section 33 of the said Act shall apply to the said society with certain modifications and to permit the Registrar of Co-operative Societies (Fisheries) to appoint a new administrator for a period of six months from 26th April, 2014 to 25th October, 2014 or till a newly elected committee enters upon office, whichever is earlier to avoid administrative vacuum in the said society.

The order is intended to achieve the above object.
