
As per the orders and circular cited above, Government have issued detailed instructions regarding expenditure which can be incurred from SDRF towards the functioning of Covid First Line Treatment Centres, Institutional Quarantine Centres and Covid Care Centres. It has been noticed that District Collectors are submitting proposals requesting huge amount from SDRF for this purpose without considering the references cited . In this circumstance following instructions are issued for the timely settlement of pending bills in connection with the running of CCC/CFLTC/Institution Quarantine Centres:

1.Local Self Government Institutions have been empowered to use their own and plan funds for clearing pending Covid 19 bills of certain categories of expenses . Such pending bills are to be cleared through the Administrative Committees concerned.

2.All premises taken over by District Disaster Management Authority for Covid First Line Treatment Center(CFLTC) etc are to be reimbursed to the owners. The pendency noticed in districts is to be cleared immediately and should be reported to Government.

Local Self Government institutions have been empowered to use their
own and other funds for clearing pending Covid 19 bills of certain categories of
expenditure. Such pending bills are to be cleared through the Administrative
Committee concerned.

All pending bills over by District Disaster Management Authority for
Covid First Line Treatment Centres (CFLTC) are to be returned to the
owner. The pending bills to Districts to be cleared immediately and
should be returned to Government.
