#### ORDER

As per the Government Order read 1st paper above, revised Administrative sanction was issued for the relocation of 438 families from private settlements within the forest areas of Kannur, South Wayanad, Mannarkkad and Thiruvananthapuram Forest Divisions at a cost of Rs.6570 lakh, as shown below, approved under the Project FOR001-00 "Fencing along Forest Boundary under the Special Investment Plan" Phase-II.

- 2. As per letter read 2<sup>nd</sup> paper above, the Principal Chief Conservator of Forests and Head of Forest Force reported that, the Divisional Forest Officer, Mannarkkad has informed that 63 families in Melekalam settlement are not willing to move out and therefore this settlement may be exempted from the approved list of relocation.
- 3. In the meantime, the Divisional Forest Officer, Thiruvananthapuram has requested to additionally include Dallikarikkam settlement in Kulathupuzha Village to the list of private settlements to be relocated in the Division since all the 126 eligible families in the settlement are willing to be relocated and that the consent of these eligible families have been received. Hence, the following modification is proposed for relocation of settlement under the project aided by KIIFB:-

Government have examined the matter in detail and are pleased to exclude Melekalam settlement in Mannarkkad Division from the Government Order read 1<sup>st</sup> paper above and include Dallikarikkam settlement in Thiruvananthapuram Division from relocation under Phase-II of KIIFB project as tabled above. Thus, the total number of willing eligible families to be relocated are increased from 438 to 501 and the estimated expenditure is also increased from Rs.6570.00 lakh to Rs.7515.00 lakh. The additional amount required as per the present modification of relocation component can be accommodated within the total project cost (from the savings of existing project components) approved as per the Government Order read 1<sup>st</sup> paper above.
