ORDER

As per the G.O. read as 1st paper above, in principle approval was accorded for establishing a Zoological Park, under the Forest Department, at Thrissur District, by winding up the existing Thrissur Zoo. Accordingly, steps were taken to establish 'Thrissur Zoological Park' with an extent of 136.28 hectare of forest land, situated at Puthur, comes under the Thrissur Forest Division. The Project was started by obtaining clearance from the MoEF&CC, in accordance with the Forest Conservation Act,1980, Wildlife (Protection) Act,1972 and Environment Protection Act,1986.

- 2) As decided in the meeting held on 19/08/2020, to finalize the modalities of shifting process of Zoo, the Special Officer (Elephant Rehabilitation Centre, Kottoor & Puthur Zoological Park), *vide* the letter read as 2nd paper above, furnished a proposal to the Government to issue formal orders for according sanction to shift the animals from the existing Thrissur Zoo to 'Thrissur Zoological Park', as and when the enclosures are ready for shifting the animals.
- 3) The Special Officer has reported that the construction of the 'Thrissur Zoological Park' is in the advanced stage, in which work of 4 No.

of animal Enclosures, in Phase I, has been completed and that of 8 No. of Enclosures, in Phase II, along with Compound Wall, Hospital Complex for Animals, Animal Kitchen, Isolation and Quarantine Centre, post-mortem Room and water supply arrangements and other essential amenities would be completed by the end of December, 2020. He has, therefore, requested to accord in principle sanction to relocate the animals in the Thrissur Zoo to the 'Thrissur Zoological Park'.

4) Government have examined the proposal, in detail, and are pleased to accord in principle sanction to relocate the animals from the Thrissur Zoo to the 'Thrissur Zoological Park', subject to the receipt of necessary approval from the Central Zoo Authority, for the functioning of the 'Thrissur Zoological Park'.
