

## GOVERNMENT OF KERALA

### PERSONNEL & ADMINISTRATIVE REFORMS (AR-12) DEPARTMENT

Applications are invited from eligible candidates for filling up two anticipated vacancies for the post of Judicial Members in the Kerala Administrative Tribunal.

**2. Qualification for appointment as a Judicial Member, Kerala Administrative Tribunal.** (The Administrative Tribunals Act, 1985 as amended by the Administrative Tribunals (Amendment) Act, 2006).

The eligibility conditions for appointment as a Judicial Member as per sub-section 2(b) of section 6 of the Administrative Tribunals Act, 1985 as amended by the Administrative Tribunals (Amendment) Act, 2006 provides that-

"6(2) A person shall not be qualified for appointment,-

(b) As a judicial Member, unless he is or qualified to be a Judge of a High Court or he has for at least two years held the post of a Secretary to the Government of India in the Department of Legal Affairs or the Legislative Department including Member Secretary, Law Commission of India or held a post of Additional Secretary to the Government of India in the Department of Legal Affairs and Legislative Department at least for a period of five years.

3. As per sub-sections (2) and (3) of section 8 of the Administrative Tribunals Act, 1985 as amended by the Administrative Tribunals (Amendment) Act, 2006 (Central Act, 1 of 2007) :-

"(2) A Member shall hold office as such for a term of five years from the date on which he enters upon his office extendable by one more term of five years:

Provided that no Member shall hold office as such after he has attained the age of sixty-five years.

(3) The conditions of service of Chairman and Members shall be the same as applicable to Judges of the High Court."

4. Eligible persons who are willing to be considered for the post of Judicial Member in the Kerala Administrative Tribunal may forward their applications in the prescribed proforma (attached). While forwarding the applications, the following points may be kept in mind:-

- (i) Knowledge and experience in dealing with service matters and laws would be essential.
- (ii) It should be clearly stated that the candidate is clear from vigilance angle. In case any penalty has been imposed in the past against any officer under the relevant Service Rules, the details of the same may also be furnished.
- (iii) Original CR dossiers, failing which certified copies of Confidential Reports of candidates for the last ten years may also be sent along with applications. If these stipulations cannot be complied with, the reasons thereof may be stated.
- (iv) Interested applicants may also send advance copies of their applications. However, advance copies of the applications would be considered only if the actual applications are later received with all the above necessary requirements from the cadre controlling authorities, before 23.07.2021.
- (v) **The applications should reach the Additional Chief Secretary, Personnel and Administrative Reforms Department, Secretariat, Thiruvananthapuram before 5 pm on 23.7.2021.**
- (v) (a) Members of Bar should attach certificate of Practice from the Judge/Judicial Officer or from the Registry or Principal Administrative Officer of the Court concerned to prove their qualification to become High Court Judge as per Article 217(2) of Constitution of India.

5. Persons selected will have to join within three weeks from the date of issue of appointment order, failing which the appointment would be cancelled.
