## ORDER

Government have sanctioned an amount of Rs.15,00,000/(Rs.Fifteen Lakhs only) as IFMA as per Government Order read as $1^{\text {st }}$ paper above for the Liver Transplant Surgery to Sri.K.Ramesan, UD Typist at KIMS Hospital, Thiruvananthapuram. Out of Rs.15,00,000/-, only Rs.13,50,000/- (Rs.Thirteen Lakhs Fifty thousand only) was spent and the balance amount of Rs.1,50,000/-(Rs.One Lakh Fifty thousand only) was remitted back to Government exchequer by the incumbent. Afterwards when he applied for medical reimbursement claim an amount of Rs.6,29,898/- being the $80 \%$ of the admissible amount of Rs.7,87,373/-verified by Director of Health Services was sanctioned to him as per government Order read as $2^{n d}$ paper above as medical reimbursement claim and with the amount to be adjusted in his IFMA.
2) The Chief Engineer(I\&A) as per letter read as $4^{\text {th }}$ paper above has reported that due to the huge expense of continuing treatment after liver transplant surgery and the consequent debt incurred by Sri.Ramesan, he is not in a position to remit that amount to Government exchequer.
3) The incumbent has retired on June 2017 and due to the educational expenses of his son and daughter, his own treatment since 2013, expenses of Liver Biopsy and continuing treatment, he has
represented to exempt him from remitting the outstanding balance due to Government.
4) Government have examined the matter in detail and are pleased to order to write off the amount of Rs.7,20,102/-(Rs.Seven Lakhs Twenty thousand One Hundred and Two only) to be recouped as per Government Order read as $2^{\text {nd }}$ paper above from the medial reimbursement claim sanctioned to Sri.K.Ramesan, UD Typist.
