S. R. O. No. 154/2017.—WHEREAS, in exercise of the powers conferred by sub-sections (1), (2) and (3) of section 3 of the Kerala Fishermen Debt Relief Commission Act, 2008 (18 of 2008), the Government of Kerala as per notification issued under G. O. (P) No. 14/2015/F&PD dated 28th March, 2015 and published as S.R.O No. 172/2015 in the Kerala Gazette Extraordinary No. 712 dated 28th March, 2015 reconstituted the Kerala State Fishermen Debt Relief Commission for the purpose of exercising the powers and discharging the duties under the said Act:

AND WHEREAS, the term of the Commission reconstituted as such will expire on 27th March, 2017;

AND WHEREAS, proviso to section 4 of the Kerala Fishermen Debt Relief Commission Act, 2008 (18 of 2008) empowers Government to extend the term of the Commission to such period as it deems necessary;

AND WHEREAS, Government deems it necessary to extend the term of the Kerala State Fishermen Debt Relief Commission for a period of one year with effect from 28th March, 2017;

AND WHEREAS, Government deems it necessary to reconstitute the Kerala State Fishermen Debt Relief Commission for the purpose of exercising the powers and discharging the duties under the said Act;

NOW, THEREFORE, in exercise of the powers conferred by the proviso under section 4 of the Kerala Fishermen Debt Relief Commission Act, 2008 (18 of 2008), the Government of Kerala hereby extend the term of the Kerala State Fishermen Debt Relief Commission for a period of one year with effect from 28th March, 2017 and in exercise of the powers conferred by sub-sections (1), (2) and (3) of section 3 of the Kerala Fishermen Debt Relief Commission Act, 2008 (18 of 2008), the Government of Kerala hereby reconstitute the Kerala State Fishermen Debt Relief Commission with the following composition:

Explanatory Note

(This does not form part of the notification, but is intended to indicate its general purport.)

Sub-section (1) of section 3 of the Kerala Fishermen Debt Relief Commission Act, 2008 (Act 18 of 2008) empowers the State Government to constitute the Kerala State Fishermen Debt Relief Commission. Sub-section (2) thereof specifies the manner in which the Commission has to be constituted and sub-section (3) thereof empowers the State Government to nominate the Chairperson and Members of the Commission. Government have decided to reconstitute the said Commission with Justice (Rtd.) P. S. Gopinathan as Chairperson and Adv. V. V. Saseendran, Sri Koottayi Basheer, Sri T. J. Anjalose and Sri T. N. Prathapan as Members in accordance with the above provisions and to extend the term of the Commission for a period of one year with effect from 28th March, 2017 as per proviso to section 4 of the Act.

The notification is intended to achieve the above object.
