ORDER

As per Government Order read as 1st paper above, Administrative sanction was accorded for the following two projects under NABARD-RIDF XIX.

1. Project proposal for Mitigation of Man-Animal Conflict in South Wayanad with updated cost of Rs.1685 lakh.
2. Project proposals for developing Modern Wildlife Interpretation Centre at Thekkady with updated cost of Rs.435.39 lakh.

(2) As per Government Order read as 2nd paper above, sanction was also accorded for the execution of the above projects through Kerala State Police Housing Construction Corporation.

(3) As per Government Order read as 3rd paper above, sanction was accorded for release of mobilization advance to Kerala State Police Housing Construction Corporation being 20% of the Project Cost.

(4) As per the letter read as 4th paper above, Principal Chief Conservator of Forests (Wildlife) & Chief Wildlife Warden has informed that the authorities of Kerala State Police Housing Construction Corporation expressed their technical inability and non-capability to undertake works related to nature conservation activities like Wildlife Interpretation Centre at Thekkady and the Principal Chief Conservator of Forests (Wildlife) & Chief Wildlife Warden has requested to entrust the work to M/s KITCO.

(5) As per the letter read as 5th paper above, Principal Chief Conservator of Forests (D&PFM) has informed that no advance was released to Kerala State Police Housing Construction Corporation as they had expressed their unwillingness to implement the project .

(6) Government examined the matter in detail and are pleased to accord sanction for entrusting the execution of the NABARD – RIDF XIX project - “Developing Modern Wildlife Interpretation Centre at Thekkady” with M/s KITCO Limited.


