Sub: DMD - Flood 2020 - Minimum relief for house damages and immediate assistance - Reg

Ref: Minutes of State Executive Committee of Kerala State Disaster Management Authority held on 25.01.2021.

As 2020 monsoon did not cause extreme flood situation in the state as that of in 2018 or 2019 and that there was no notification of flood/landslide areas as per norms other than at Pettimudi, Idukki District, relief for livelihood loss (immediate assistance of Rs.10,000) can only be paid to the landslide affected families of Pettimudi, Idukki. Therefore no relief for livelihood loss in areas outside Pettimudi, Idukki can be granted for the disasters during the monsoon season of 2020, from State Disaster Response Fund(SDRF).
