The following draft rules further to amend the Kerala Motor Vehicles Rules, 1989, which the Government of Kerala propose to make in exercise of the powers conferred by clause (p) of Sub-section (2) of section 65 of the Motor Vehicles Act, 1988 (Central Act 59 of 1988) is hereby published for general information as required by sub-section (1) of Section 212 of the said Act.

Notice is hereby given that the said draft will be taken up for consideration on or after thirty days from the date of publication of this notification in the Gazette and that objections or suggestions, if any, that may be received from any person in respect of the draft rules on or before the period specified above will be considered by the Government. Objections or suggestions, if any, in duplicate, shall be addressed to the Principal Secretary to Government, Transport Department, Government Secretariat, Thiruvananthapuram.

## DRAFT RULES

- 1. Short title and commencement .- (1) These rules may be called the Kerala Motor Vehicles (...... Amendment) Rules, 2018.
  - (2) They shall come into force at once.
- 2. Amendment of the Rules.- In the Kerala Motor Vehicles Rules, 1989, in rule 92 A, in item (x),-
- (i) after the sentence ending with the words "during the tenure of their office", the following sentence shall be inserted namely:-

"The Deputy Directors of Prosecution in the State are entitled to use a board both in front and rear of the vehicle bearing the designation other than the board showing registration mark.";

(ii) in the last sentence, for the words "the officers of and above the rank of Deputy Secretary in the Government Secretariat and the Chairman of the Permanent Lok Adalat", the following words and symbol shall be substituted, namely:-

"the officers of and above the rank of Deputy Secretary in the Government Secretariat, the Chairman of the Permanent Lok Adalat and Deputy Directors of Prosecution".
