ORDER

As per letter read as 1st paper above, Government of India, Ministry of Environment & Forests, Bangalore had accorded in principal Stage I approval for the diversion of 4.4 ha. of forest land for the electrification of Chembanaruvy Colony in Mannarappara Range in Punalur Division under MLA-LAD Scheme, subject to the certain conditions.

- But the User Agency (KSEB) had commissioned the project in the forest area without payment of Net Present Value and Compensatory Afforestation charges and without obtaining stage-II clearance under Forest (Conservation) Act, 1980. Later the User Agency (KSEB) has remitted the Net Present Value and Compensatory Afforestation charges and complied the conditions stipulated in the Government of India in the primary approval.
- As per letter read as 2nd paper above, Government of India, Ministry of 3. Environment & Forests, Bangalore had issued Stage II approval under Section 2 of Forest (Conservation) Act, 1980 for diversion of 4.4 ha. of forest land, ie. 3.88 ha of forest land in Punalur Division and 0.52 ha of forest land in Konni Forest Division in Kollam District for electrification of Chembanaruvy Colony in Mannarappara Forest Range under MLA-LAD Scheme in favour of Kerala State Electricity Board, Pathanapuram for a period of 20 years, subject to the conditions specified in reference 2nd cited.

4. In the circumstances, expost facto sanction is accorded for diversion of 4.4 ha. of forest land in Punalur Division and Konni Forest Division in Kollam District for the electrification of Chembanaruvy Colony in Mannarappara Range in Punalur Division under MLA-LAD Scheme in favour of Kerala State Electricity Board, Pathanapuram subject to the conditions stipulated in Government of India letter read as 2nd paper above.
