ORDER

The Principal Chief Conservator of Forest (F,L&R)& NO as per the letter 1st read—above has recommended and forwarded the proposal for diversion of 0.077 ha of forest land under section 2 of Forest (Conservation) Act, 1980 for electrification of Makkuvally area in Idukki District falls in Thodupuzha Range of Kothamangalam Forest Division under total electrification scheme. The Executive Engineer, Electrical Division, KSEBL, Kattappana is the User Agency. The proposal is for laying 11 KV UG cable through reserve forest existing coupe road over a distance of 2.2 Km length and 0.35 M width in Thodupuzha Range of Kothamangalam Division. The proposal is beneficial for 100 families of Makkuvally area.

2. Government have examined the proposal in detail on the basis of the guidelines issued by the Government of India as per the letter 2nd read above and are pleased to accord sanction for the above proposal subject to the following conditions:-

- 1. Legal status of the forest shall remain unchanged.
- 2. The User Agency shall give undertaking to pay Net Present Value as per guidelines issued by Government of India.
- 3. The User Agency shall give an undertaking to pay additional Net Present Value if required.
- 4. The User Agency shall make online payment of Net Present Value with ad-hoc CAMPA through e-payment module of forest clearance portal (forestclearance.nic.in), if demanded.
- 5. The User Agency shall not fell any trees or cause damage to the surrounding forest and shall take all possible measures to conserve tree growth.
- 6. The User Agency shall not use the forest land for any purpose other than the purpose for which the forest land is diverted.
- 7. When the forest land is no longer required for the purpose, the land will be resumed back to the Forest Department.
- 8. The User Agency shall abide by any other condition imposed later on by Government of India/Government of Kerala/Forest Department in the interest of Forest Conservation.
- 9. The User Agency has to check the UG cable in definite frequent inspection with permission from Divisional Forest Officer to prevent any danger to wildlife.
- 10. The User Agency shall apply for renewal of approval after 10 years.
- 11. The User Agency has to sign an agreement with Divisional Forest Officer, Kothamangalam incorporating all the conditions imposed by Government of India/ Government of Kerala/ Kerala Forest Department in this regard and a nominal lease rent as decided by the Government of

Kerala may be remitted.
