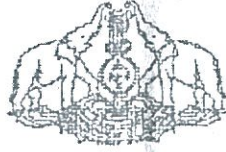

C I R C U L A R

Sub:-H&FWD – Practice of Medical Officers in continuing in their preferable stations after receiving transfer / promotion orders from Government and expiry of sanctioned working arrangement period - Instructions issued.

It has come to the notice of Government that there is a tendency on the part of Doctors under the Health Services to continue in their favourite choice of stations, even after transfer / promotion orders are issued and the sanctioned working arrangement period expired.

In this circumstance the following instructions are issued for strict compliance:

- (i) Superintendents of the institutions and District Medical Officers shall ensure prompt relieving of the Medical Officers to their transferred / promoted stations. In cases of working arrangement, the Superintendents should relieve them to previous stations where lien is retained immediately on the expiry of the sanctioned period of working arrangement. Any failure in this regard will invite disciplinary action.
- (ii) The action of the Director of Health Services and District Medical Officers in sanctioning working arrangement to Medical Officers will be viewed seriously, since they are not competent to do so.
