ORDER

As per the letter read above the principal Chief Conservator of Forests & Head of Forest Force has reported that Ministry of Environment and forests, Government of India have revised and renamed the centrally Sponsored Scheme: Intensification of Forest Management (IFMS) as Forest Fire prevention and Management scheme (FPMS) and issued operational guidelines for this scheme. This scheme focuses solely on the issue of Forest Fire Prevention and Management and related activities to address the growing concern over adverse effects of forest fire.

2) As per the operational guideline, a State Level Monitoring Committee (SLMC) shall be formed in the State under the Chairmanship of Principal Chief Conservator of Forests (HOFF) with Nodal Officer for the scheme as Member Secretary for periodic monitoring and review of the scheme. The Committee should have at least two members from outside the Government Departments of State. Accordingly Principal Chief Conservator of Forests & Head of Forest Force recommended to constitute the State Level Monitoring Committee (SLMC) with the following

members.

1. Principal Chief conservator of Forests (Forests Management)
- Chairman
2. Principal chief conservator Of Forests(Wild Life) or his representative
- Member
3. Principal chief Conservator of Forests (Forest, Land & Resources) or his representative
- Member
4. Shri. T.R. Vinod, Centre for Environment & Development
- Member
5. Shri.E.V. Anoop, Professor and Head, Forest Products and Utilization Dept, Forestry college, Kerala Agricultural University
- Member
6. Additional Principal Chief Conservator of Forests (Finance, Budget &- Audit) & Nodal Officer
- Member Secretary
