<u>ORDER</u>

The Principal Chief Conservator of Forest (Forest, Land & Resources) & Nodal Officer as per the letter 1st read—above has recommended and forwarded the proposal for diversion of 0.1224 ha of forest land under section 2 of Forest (Conservation) Act, 1980 for electrification of Kochukoottakallu area of Karimannoor Grama Panchayath in Idukki District falls in Kothamangalam Forest Division under total electrification scheme. The Executive Engineer, Electrical Division, KSEBL, Thodupuzha is the User Agency. The proposal is for drawing LT OH line with a length of 408 M and width 3 M through coupe road of 1959 teak plantation Kaliyar Range of Kothamangalam Division for providing electricity to 2 families of Kochukoottakallu area in Karimannoor Grama Panchayath.

2. Government have examined the proposal in detail based on the guidelines issued by the Government of India as per the letter 2nd read above and are pleased to accord sanction for the above proposal subject to the following conditions:

- 1.3 cgal status of the forest shall remain unshoused
- 2. The User Agency shall given an undertaking to pay Net Present Value as per guidelines issued by Government of India.
- 3. The User Agency shall give an undertaking to pay additional Net Present Value if required.
- 4. The User Agency shall make online payment of Net Present Value with ad-hoc CAMPA through e-payment module of forest clearance portal. (forestclearance.nic.in), if demanded.
- 5. The User Agency shall not fell any frees if demanded or cause damage to the surrounding forest and shall take all possible measures to conserve tree growth.
- 6. The User Agency shall not use the forest land for any purpose other than the purpose for which the forest land is diverted.
- 7. When the forest land is no longer required for the purpose, the land will be resumed back to the Forest Department.
- 8. The User Agency shall abide by any other condition imposed later on by Government of India/Government of Kerala/Forest Department in the interest of Forest Conservation.
- 9. The User Agency shall apply for renewal of approval after 10 years.
- 10. The User Agency has to sign an agreement with Divisional Forest Officer, Kothamangalam incorporating all the conditions imposed by Government of India/Government of Kerala/ Kerala Forest Department in this regard and a nominal lease rent as decided by the Government of Kerala may be remitted.
