ORDER

The Principal Chief Conservator of Forests (Wildlife) & Chief Wildlife Warden, has submitted a proposal for exempting the general public from payment of entry fee to visit the Tiger Reserves, Sanctuaries and National Parks, during the Wildlife Week Celebrations, 2011, scheduled to be held from 02nd to 08th October, 2011 and the winners of the Wildlife Week Competition, 2011 from paying the entry fee to all protected areas of the State for the next one year from 08th October, 2011.

Government have examined the matter in detail and are pleased to accord sanction as follows.

- (i) Exempting the general public from paying entry fee to visit Tiger Reserves, Sanctuaries and National Parks during the Wildlife Week 2011, from 02<sup>nd</sup> to 08<sup>th</sup> October, 2011.
- (ii) Exempting the winners of the Wildlife Week competitions 2011, from paying entry fee to all the Protected Areas of the State for the next one year from 02<sup>nd</sup> October, 2011.
