ORDER

Principal Chief Conservator of Forest (F,L&R) & NO has submitted a proposal under Forest (Conservation) Act, 1980 for diversion of 0.0820 ha of forest land in Pattikkad Range of Thrissur Division for widening of existing two Lane National Highway into Six Lane National Highway from Vadakkenchery to Mannuthy in favour of Project Director, NHA Palakkad as per the letter read as 1st paper above. The proposal is for widening of existing Two Lane NH 47 into Six Lane Highway from Vadakkenchery to Mannuthy (KM.240 to KM.270) under the National Highway Development Programme (NHDP).

As per the general approval guidelines issued by Government of India vide letter read as 2nd paper above, Government have examined the matter in detail and are pleased to accord sanction for the above proposal subject to the following conditions:

1. Legal status of the forest shall remains unchanged.
2. The User Agency shall pay Net Present Value as per guidelines issued by Government of India.
3. The User Agency shall give an undertaking to pay additional Net Present Value if required.
4. Cost of raising of 10 times the number of trees to be felled shall be deposited by the User Agency.
5. The User Agency shall make online payment of cost of Compensatory Afforestation and Net Present Value with ad-hoc CAMPA through e-

- payment module of forest clearance portal.(forestclearance.nic.in).
6. The User Agency shall not fell any trees other than marked for felling or cause damage to the surrounding forest and shall take all possible measures to conserve tree growth.
 7. The User Agency shall not use the forest land for any purpose other than the purpose for which the forest land is diverted.
 8. When the forest land is no longer required for the purpose, the land will be resumed back to the Forest Department.
 9. The User Agency shall abide by any other condition imposed later on by Government of Kerala/Forest Department in the interest of Forest Conservation.
 10. The User Agency shall apply for renewal of approval after 10 years.
 11. The User Agency has to sign an agreement with Divisional Forest Officer incorporating all the conditions imposed by Government of India/Government of Kerala in this regard and a nominal lease rent as decided by the Government of India may be remitted.
