Sub:- Higher Education - Guidelines formulated for obtaining approval for new Colleges/new courses in the existing Colleges/increase in intake of existing courses - Amendment instructions - Reg.

As per Circulars cited above, Government have formulated guidelines for obtaining approval for new Colleges/new courses in the existing Colleges/increase in intake of existing courses. As per the letter cited as 4th paper above the Director of Technical Education requested Government to re-fix the processing fee structure.

In the above circumstances Government have decided to re-fix the processing fee for starting new Colleges/new courses in the existing Colleges/increase in intake of existing courses/extension of approval as follows:

i)	For new institutions	---	Rs.25,000/-
ii)	For additional courses/ Increase in intake	---	Rs.15,000/-
iii)	For extension of Approval	---	Rs.10,000/-
