<u>ORDER</u>

The Additional Principal Chief Conservator of Forests (FMIS), vide letter read as 1st paper above, has submitted a proposal for the procurement of 90 Nos. of Personal Computers at a total cost of Rs.36,63,387/-lakh (Rupees Thirty Six Lakh Sixty Three Thousand Three Hundred and Eighty Seven only) from M/s Absolut Technologies, Thiruvananthapuram under DGS & D rate contract as detailed below;

- 2) The Departmental Working Group Meeting held on 19/10/2015, considered the proposal of Additional Principal Chief Conservator of Forests (FMIS) and agreed to give Administrative Sanction for the procurement of 90 Nos. of Personal Computers at a total cost of Rs.36,63,387/-lakh (Rupees Thirty Six Lakh Sixty Three Thousand Three Hundred and Eighty Seven only) from M/s Absolut Technologies, Thiruvananthapuram with the following conditions;
 - 1. Administrative Sanction may be issued for the procurement of 40 Computers for which administrative approval has been given by Government of India from JICA fund.
 - 2. 3 years warranty period should be ensured now.
 - 3. AMC for the 4th and 5th year shall not be considered.
- 3) Based on the decision taken in the Departmental Working Group Meeting held on 19.10.2015, report of Additional Principal Chief Conservator of Forests (FMIS) read as 3rd paper above and as per Government Orders read as 4th and 5th papers above, Government are pleased to accord sanction for the purchase of 90 Nos. of Personal Computers at a total cost of Rs.36,63,387/-lakh (Rupees Thirty Six Lakh Sixty Three Thousand Three Hundred and Eighty Seven only) as detailed below from M/s Absolut Technologies, Thiruvananthapuram with the following conditions;
 - 1. Administrative Sanction will issued for the procurement of 40 Computers for which administrative approval has been given by Government of India from JICA fund.
 - 2. 3 years warranty period should be ensured now.
 - 3. AMC for the 4^{th} and 5^{th} year will not be considered.
