ORDER

As per the G.O read as 2nd paper above administrative sanction was accorded for the project 'Fencing along forest boundary - Phase I' for an amount of Rs. 25 crores with KIIFB financial assistance. The project is being implemented through State Forest Development Agency (SFDA) as the special purpose vehicle. The components of the project were as follows:

But, as per letter read as 4th paper above the Principal Chief Conservator of Forests (Forest Management) informed that despite tendering for many times, the solar power fence works could be arranged only for 59.5 km and 5.35 km rail fence in Walayar could not commence due to the issue of 50% sharing of the cost of rail fence between Kerala Government and Railways. Hence Principal Chief Conservator of Forests (Forest Management) suggested to modify the Phase I components as shown

below as there is no significant progress in these works for availing financial resources from KIIFB.

Government have examined the matter in detail. All the above works are already in the DPR approved by KIIFB. In addition to 6 km rail fencing in Begur range for which Technical Sanction is awaited, the Department will be able to construct 10 km Rail Fencing in Wayanad Wildlife Sanctuary which is vulnerable to elephant attacks as evident from many recent deaths there.

In the circumstances, government are pleased to accord Revised Administrative Sanction for the project 'Fencing Along Forest Boundary' - Phase I for an amount of Rs. 25.00 crore (Rupees Twenty Five Crore only) as proposed above with KIIFB assistance.

State Forest Development Agency (SFDA) is designated as the Special Purpose Vehicle (SPV) for the implementation of the project.
