ORDER

- 1) Government have been promoting partnership with Private Hospitals for Covid prevention and mitigation activities.
- 2) In order to facilitate vaccine procurement by the Private Hospitals, as per the Ministry of Health and Family Welfare, Government of India guidelines, Managing Director, Kerala Medical Services Corporation Limited is authorized as an aggregator.
- 3) State Health Agency have been interacting with Private Hospitals and assessed the demand of vaccines for the month of August around 18.18 lakh dosage.
- 4) As per letter read above, the Mananging Director, Kerala Medical Services Corporation Limited requested Government to allot Rs. 126,00,00,000/- (Rupees One Hundred and Twenty Six Crore only) for advance payment to M/s Serum Institute Life Science Private Limited for the procurement of Covishield vaccine.
 - 5) Government have examined the matter in detail and are pleased to accord

DRAFT NOTE FOR THE COUNCIL OF MINISTERS

This note deals with the ratification of the action in having issued GO (Rt) No. 1714/2021/H&FWD dated 10/08/2021 giving permission to Kerala Medical Services Corporation Ltd, to procure 20 lakh doses of Covishield Vaccine from M/s Serum Institute of India utilising the fund from CMDRF, for distribution through private hospitals subject to the condition that the cost of vaccine shall be charged from the private hospitals.

- 2. Government have decided to conduct a mass vaccination campaign in the public and private sectors across the state to ensure maximum vaccination. Government is of the opinion that the daily doses of COVID-19 vaccines administered must be increased considerably and the thrust shall be on procuring as aggregator and give to Private Sector Hospitals to do vaccination at a faster pace.
- 3. To facilitate vaccine procurement by the Private Hospitals, as per the Ministry of Health and Family Welfare, Government of India guidelines, Managing Director, Kerala Medical Services Corporation Limited is authorized as an aggregator. State Health Agency has been interacting with Private Hospitals and assessed the demand of vaccines for the month of August which is around 18.18 lakh dosage.
- 4. Managing Director, Kerala Medical Services Corporation Limited requested Government to allot Rs. 1,26,00,00,000/- (Rupees One Hundred and Twenty Six Crore only) for advance payment to M/s Serum Institute Life Science Private Limited for the procurement of 20 lakh doses of Covishield vaccine.
- 5. When the file was circulated to the Hon'ble Chief Minister for orders, the Hon'ble Chief Minister ordered the following:

6. As per the order ante, Government have issued GO(Rt) No. 1714/2021/H&FWD dated 10.08.2021 by giving permission to KMSCL to procure 20 lakh doses of Covishield Vaccine from M/s Serum Institute of India for distribution through private hospitals subject to the following conditions;

- the cost of vaccine shall be charged from the private hospitals.
- Managing Director, Kerala Medical Services Corporation Limited shall do procurement of 20 lakh doses of vaccines in two batches of 10 lakh vaccines each, from the manufacturer.
- MD, Kerala Medical Services Corporation Limited and Executive Director, State Health Agency shall work out accounting details regarding vaccine supply to the Private Hospitals and remit the cost of vaccines collected from Private Hospitals in the account of CMDRF.
- The expenses for the procurement of vaccine as an aggregator shall be provided from the CMDRF.
- 7. Thereafter, Revenue (DRF) Department has accorded sanction to release an amount of Rs. 63 Crore (Sixty-Three Crore only) as first installment to Managing Director, KMSCL for procuring vaccine as per GO(Rt) No. 2822/2021/Rev dated 18.08.2021.
