## Personnel and Administrative Reforms (AR-12) Department

#### NOTIFICATION

- G.O. (P) No. 18/2010/P&ARD Dated, Thiruvananthapuram, 26th May, 2010.
- S. R. O. No. 516/2010.—In exercise of the powers conferred by section 12, read with clause (a) and (c) of section 36 of the Administrative Tribunals Act, 1985 (Central Act 13 of 1985), the State Government do hereby make the following rules, namely:—

#### RULES

- 1. Short title and commencement.—(1) These rules may be called the Kerala Administrative Tribunal (Financial and Administrative Powers) Rules, 2010.
  - (2) They shall come into force at once.
  - 2. Definitions.—In these rules, unless the context otherwise requires,—
    - (a) "Act" means the Administrative Tribunals Act, 1985 (Central Act 13 of 1985).

- (b) "Chairman" means the Chairman of the Tribunal.
- (c) "Tribunal" means the Kerala Administrative Tribunal.
- 3. Powers of Chairman.—(1) The Chairman shall have the same powers as are conferred on a Head of the Department in the State Government in respect of the Kerala Service Rules, the Kerala Financial Code, the Kerala Treasury Code, the Kerala Account Code, the Kerala Budget Manual, the Kerala State and Subordinate Service Rules, the Kerala Civil Services (Classification, Control and Appeal) Rules, the Kerala Government Servant's Conduct Rules, the Kerala General Provident Fund Rules and the Kerala Government Servants Medical Attendance Rules:

Provided that the exercise of the financial powers shall be subject to any procedural or other instructions which may be issued from time to time by the Government.

(2) The Officers and other employees of the Tribunal shall be under the administrative and disciplinary control of the Chairman.

## **Explanatory Note**

(This does not form part of the notification, but is intended to indicate its general purport.)

Section 36 of the Administrative Tribunals Act, 1985 empowers the State Government to make rules to provide for the financial and administrative powers, which the Chairman of a Tribunal may exercise over the Benches of the Tribunal under section 12 of the Act.

This notification is intended to achieve the above purpose.
