ORDER

G.O. (P) No. 120/2011/Co-op. Dated, Thiruvananthapuram, 26th August, 2011.

S. R. O. No. 643/2011.—WHEREAS, under sub-section (1) of section 33 of the Kerala Co-operative Societies Act, 1969 (21 of 1969), the term of an administrator or administrative committee, appointed to manage the affairs of a society shall not exceed one year in the aggregate;

AND WHEREAS, the said term of one year of the administrator appointed to manage the affairs of the Perumbavoor Scheduled Caste Multipurpose Co-operative Society Ltd. No. E. 504 in Ernakulam District under sub-section (1) of section 33 of the said Act expired on 22nd April, 2010;

AND WHEREAS, under sub-section (1A) of section 33 of the said Act, the Government may, by notification in the Gazette, for reasons to be recorded, permit the Registrar of Co-operative Societies to extend the term of the said administrator or administrative committee for a further period not exceeding one year in the aggregate or till a newly elected committee enters upon office, whichever is earlier;

AND WHEREAS, the Registrar of Co-operative Societies has reported that the election to the Board of Directors of the said society could not be conducted within the period due to the poor financial status of the said society and has requested to extend the term of the administrator of the said society for a further period of 18 months from 23rd April, 2010 to 22nd October, 2011;

AND WHEREAS, the Government are satisfied that it is necessary, in the public interest, direct that the provisions of sub-section (1A) of section 33 of the said Act shall apply to the said society with certain modifications and to permit the Registrar of Co-operative Societies to extend the term of the administrator appointed to manage the affairs of the said society for a further period of 18 months from 23rd April, 2010 to 22nd October, 2011 to avoid administrative vacuum in the said society;

Now, Therefore, in exercise of the powers conferred by section 101 of the Kerala Co-operative Societies Act, 1969 (21 of 1969), the Government of Kerala hereby direct that the provisions of sub-section (1A) of section 33 of the said Act shall apply to the Perumbavoor Scheduled Caste Multipurpose Co-operative Society Ltd. No. E. 504 in Ernakulam District with the modification of substitution of the words "eighteen months" for the words "one year" and in exercise of the powers under sub-section (1A) of section 33 of the said Act, as so modified, permit the Registrar of Co-operative Societies to extend the term of the administrator appointed under section 33 of the said Act to manage the affairs of the said society for a further period of 18 months from 23rd April, 2010 to 22nd October, 2011.

Explanatory Note

(This does not form part of the order, but is intended to indicate its general purport.)

The term of the administrator appointed under sub-section (1) of section 33 of the Kerala Co-operative Societies Act, 1969 (21 of 1969), to manage the affairs of the Perumbayoor Scheduled Caste Multipurpose Co-operative Society Ltd. No. E. 504 in Ernakulam District expired on 22nd April, 2010. The Registrar of Co-operative Societies has reported that the election to the Board of Directors of the said society could not be conducted within the extended period due to the poor financial status of the said society and has requested to permit him to extend the term of the administrator for a further period of eighteen months from 23rd April, 2010 to 22nd October, 2011. The Government have considered the matter in detail and are satisfied that it is necessary in the public interest, to direct that the provisions of sub-section (IA) of section 33 of the said Act shall apply to the said society with certain modifications and to permit the Registrar of Co-operative Societies to extend the term of the administrator of the said society for a further period of 18 months from 23rd April, 2010 to 22nd October, 2011, or till a newly elected committee enters upon office, whichever is earlier to avoid administrative vacuum in the said society.

The order is intended to achieve the above object.
