### ORDER

The Registrar, High Court of Kerala as per the letter read above, has requested Government to accord sanction for the purchase of 7 new higher segment vehicles for the use of Principal District Judges in the State in the I<sup>st</sup> phase at a cost not exceeding Rs.15 Lakh per vehicle. The Registrar, High Court has informed that the Principal District Judges are using Maruti Swift Desire LDI Cars and 14 Officer are now not provided with independent vehicles.

2. Government have examined the matter in detail and are pleased to accord administrative sanction for the purchase of new Premium Honda City or Maruti Ciaz vehicles for 7 Principal District Judges (out of 14), from GeM portal at a cost up to Rs 12 lakhs per car. Permission is also granted to the Registrar General, High Court to opt to hire Electric vehicles such as Hyundai Kona, for any of the 7 Principal District Judges who would like opt for this, under existing instructions issued from Finance Department.

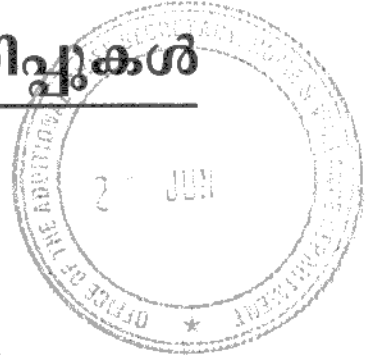

### Note for the Council of Ministers

This note deals with the purchase of 7 higher segment vehicles for the use of 7 Principal District Judges in the State.

2. The Registrar, High Court has informed that the Principal District Judges are using Maruti Swift Desire LDI cars and 14 Officers are now not provided with independent vehicles. Registrar has requested to accord administrative sanction for the purchase of 7 new higher segment vehicles for the use of Principal District Judges in the State in the 1<sup>st</sup> phase at a cost not exceeding Rs. 15 Lakh per vehicle.

3 When the matter was consulted with Finance department, that department offered the following remarks;

Finance agrees to permit purchase of new vehicles for 7 Principal District Judges (out of 14) from GeM at a cost of up to Rs.12 Lakhs per Car, since Premium Honda City and Maruti Ciaz Vehicles are available for up to Rs.12 lakhs; Hon'ble High Court may also be given an option that if they wish, they could choose to hire Electric vehicles such Hundai Kona, for any of the 7 Principal District Judges who would like opt for this, under existing instructions issued from Finance Department.

This has the approval of Hon'ble Minister (Finance)

4. Hon'ble Chief Minister has ordered to place the matter before the Council of Ministers.

1. Whether sanction may be accorded for the purchase of new Premium Honda City or Maruti Ciaz vehicles for 7 Principal District Judges (out of 14), from GeM portal at a cost up to Rs 12 lakhs per car?
2. Whether Hon'ble High Court may be given an option that if they wish, they could choose to hire Electric vehicles such as Hyundai Kona, for any of the 7 Principal District Judges who would like opt for this, under existing instructions issued from Finance Department?
