ORDER

Package No. KR 07-09 Parippu - Thollayiram - Manchira Road in Kottayam was sanctioned under PMGSY I Phase V of 2006-07 and the same was awarded to the contractor Sri. K.V. Paulose with the completion period of 12 months from 16.11.2012. During the execution, certain deviations were found necessary for the completion of the work and accordingly the revised proposal was approved for ₹12,18,99,045/-as per the Government order read as 1st paper above. But the contractor delayed the work and as the contractor failed to complete the work in time, termination was issued to the contractor with risk and cost on 16/09/2022. Later, Administrative Sanction was accorded for the rearrangement of the balance work as per the DSoR 2018 rates for ₹5,12,72,784/- as per Government order read as 2nd paper above.

2. After getting technical sanction, the work was tendered and the contractor Sri. Abdul Jaleel MM quoted 22% above the estimate rate. As the quoted rate was above estimate rate, Government gave direction to rework the estimate in the current rate and subsequently Revised Administrative Sanction was accorded amounting to ₹5,90,69,054/- as

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per Government order read as 3rd paper above.

- 3. Accordingly, the tender process was initiated and no response was received in the first tender. A single bid of Sri. Abdul Jaleel M. M. was received, when moved for e-tendering for the above work. Then quotations were again invited but the result was the same. The Technical Scrutiny Committee scrutinized the technical bid and found that the bidder was technically qualified and DSR 2018 + 10% is lowest among the three criteria as per GO(P) No.54/2019/Fin dated 04.05.2019. Then negotiation was sought from the contractor, but the contractor was not willing to negotiate further. Therefore, the Chief Engineer, KSRRDA, as per letter read as 4th paper above, has requested to approve the tender excess of ₹1,18,13,810/-, which is 20% above the estimated cost of ₹5,90,69,054/-, for awarding the contract to Sri Abdul Jaleel at ₹7,08,82,864/- including the GST.
- 4. Government have examined the matter in detail and are pleased to approve the tender excess for a quoted PAC of ₹600.70 lakhs (having a project cost of ₹708.83 lakhs) for the balance work of PMGSY Phase V, 2006 07 Package No. KR07-09 Parippu-Thollayiram Manchira Road in Kottayam district, for which Administrative Sanction was accorded for an estimate PAC of ₹500.59 lakhs (having a total project cost of ₹590.70 lakhs) as per the Government order read as 3rd paper above, with overall excess of ₹118.14 lakhs (20% tender Excess) subject to the following conditions:-
- (i) Chief Engineer, KSRRDA shall ensure the correctness of the LMR calculation.
- (ii) The work shall be completed in a time bound manner. No exclusion / abnormal reduction shall be made to critical items during execution.
- (iii) Adequate Budget provision shall be ensured / allotted to meet the tender excess.

Note for the Council of Ministers

This note deals with the approval of tender excess for PMGSY I-Package No. KR 07-09 Parippu Thollayiram – Manchira road in Kottayam.

Package No. KR 07-09 Parippu Thollayiram Manchira Road in Kottayam was sanctioned under PMGSY I Phase V of 2006-07 and the same was awarded to the contractor Sri. K.V.Paulose with the completion period of 12 months from 16.11.2012. During the execution, certain deviations were found necessary for the completion of the work and accordingly the revised proposal was approved for ₹12,18,99,045/- as per G.O(MS) No.61/2017/LSGD dated 18.03.2017. But the contractor delayed the work and as the contractor failed to complete the work in time, termination was issued to the contractor with risk and cost on 16/09/2022. Later Administrative Sanction was accorded for the rearrangement of the balance work in DSoR 2018 for ₹5,12,72,784/- as per G.O(Rt)No.1590/2023/LSGD dated 04/08/2023. After getting technical sanction, the work was tendered and the contractor Sri. Abdul Jaleel MM quoted 22% above the estimate rate. As the quoted rate was above estimate rate, Government gave direction to rework the estimate in the current rate and subsequently Revised Administrative Sanction accorded amounting to ₹5,90,69,054/- as per G.O.(Rt) No.2182/2024/LSGD dated 13/11/2024.

3. Accordingly tendering process initiated response received in the first tender and a single bid was received in e-Tender. The Technical Scrutiny Committee scrutinized the technical bid and found that the bidder was technically qualified. Thus financial bids was opened and as the contractors quoted rate is above estimate; LMR, DSR 2018 + 10%, and contractors quoted rate is compared as per GO(P) No.54/2019/Fin dated 04.05.2019 and found that the DSR 2018 + 10% rate is lowest among the three criteria. Then quotation was invited and a single bid was The Technical Scrutiny Committee scrutinized the technical bid and found that the bidder was technically qualified and DSR 2018 + 10% is lowest among the three criteria as per GO(P) No.54/2019/Fin dated 04.05.2019. Then negotiation was sought from the contractor, but the contractor was not willing to negotiate further. Therefore, the Chief Engineer, KSRRDA has requested to approve the tender excess of ₹1,18,13,810/- for awarding the contract at ₹7,08,82,864/- (20% more than the estimated cost), including GST.

4.When forwarded, Finance Department remarked as follows:-

"If the contractor is unwilling to reduce the rate and Administrative Department feels that no better offer is expected and also considering the 12 years of pendency of work and difficult working condition as stated by the contractor, AD is advised to submit the tender excess proposal of the work "Package No. KR 07-09 Parippu Thollayiram Manchira Road in Kottayam" for a quoted PAC of ₹600.70 lakhs (having a project cost of

₹708.83 lakhs) which is 20.00% above estimate PAC of ₹500.59 lakhs (having a Project cost of ₹590.70 lakhs) with overall excess of ₹118.14 lakhs to the Council of Ministers for approval subject to the following:

- a) Chief Engineer, PMGSY shall ensure the correctness of the LMR calculation.
- b) The work shall be completed in a time bound manner. No exclusion / abnormal reduction shall be made to critical items during execution.
- c) Adequate Budget provision shall be ensured / allotted to meet the tender excess."
- 5.Based on the remarks of the Finance Department, the Chief Engineer has reported that the Contractor is not willing to reduce the rate further and there is no chance for getting better offer, since the work was taken up on quotation, after failing to receive any viable bids in tendering and re tendering process. Also ₹ 23.06 Cr. have been allocated as Additional State Share in the state budget of 2025-26 and the Departmental Tender Committee can approve the tender excess, not exceeding the budget provision earmarked for the financial year.
- 6.Therefore the Hon'ble Chief Minister has ordered to place the matter before the Council of Ministers.

Whether the proposal put forward by the CE, KSRRDA, to sanction the tender excess for a quoted PAC of ₹600.70 lakhs (having a project cost of ₹708.83 lakhs) for the balance work of PMGSY Phase V, 2006 - 07 Package No. KR07-09 Parippu Thollayiram - Manchira Road in Kottayam district, for which Administrative Sanction was accorded for an estimate PAC of ₹500.59 lakhs (having a total project cost of ₹590.70 lakhs) as per G.O.(Rt) No.2182/2024/LSGD dated 13/11/2024, with overall excess of ₹118.14 lakhs (20% tender Excess) may be approved subject to the conditions laid down by the Finance Department?
