## Note for the Council of Ministers

This note deals with the amendment of $2^{\text {nd }}$ condition in the GO(MS) No.219/ 2022/REV dated 16.09.2022 as per which permissive sanction has been given for using land as entry road to the National Academy of Indirect Taxes and Narcotics, Zonal Training Institute.
2. As per GO(MS) No.594/2016/REV dtd 19.12.2016 permission was given to assign 1.4165 hectares of land in Sy.No.63/1 in Devikulam Taluk of KDH Village by realising market price of Rs 10 Lakhs per Are to Central Excise \& Customs Department for establishing an office complex and training center at KDH Village in Devikulam Taluk of Idukki District under Rule 24 of the Kerala Land Assignment Rules, 1964 . Later as per GO(MS)No.219/2022/RD dated 16.09.2022 permissive sanction was given to the Central Excise \& Customs Department for construction of 150 m long and 23 m wide access road to National Academy of Indirect Taxes and Narcotics, Zonal Training Institute from the southern side of the land alloted to NACIN reaching at Anganvadi junction through the properties in Survey No. 63/part where proposal has been submitted for Bhavanam Project and Sy. No. 843 by retaining the ownership of land in Revenue Department and subject to the following conditions:
i.The access road shall be constructed by the State Public Work Department.
ii. The fund for road construction shall be met by NACIN.
iii. This access road shall be utilized for the proposed Bhavanam project also.
3. The Additional Director, NACIN has requested that the funds could not be obtained as the ownership of the land alloted for the access road is vested in the Government of Kerala and hence requested to review GO(MS)No.219/2022/RD dated 16.09.2022. It was also informed that Kerala State GST spends approximately Rs. 2 Crores per annum on GST training, and that the proposed NACIN Zonal Campus would assist Kerala GST in reducing expenses, ensuring costeffectiveness in revenue collection, which in turn, would further enhance the already increasing revenue growth. It is pointed out that the Zonal Campus of a National Training Institute could offer authentic and professional hands-on training at Munnar, thereby effectively expanding the base of generating revenue.
4. When consulted Finance Department for concurrence, that Department opined as follows:
"Finance agrees the request of Additional Director General 1, Government of India, Ministry of Finance, Department of Revenue to review the GO(MS) No.219/2022/RD dated 16/09/2022 and to construct 150 -metre long/8metre wide access road by using the funds of Government of Kerala.

This has the approval of Hon'ble Finance Minister."
5. Subsequently, in the meeting chaired by the Chief Secretary on 24.01.2024, it was decided that the State Government would bear the construction costs of the access road by retaining the ownership with the Revenue Department and circulate the file to the Honorable Chief Minister to amend the GO(MS) No. 219/2022/RD dated 16.09.2022 with the approval of the Council of Ministers and also Finance Department shall take steps to allocate required funds if the same is not available with PWD for the construction of access road.
6. In the above circumstances when the file circulated for orders on modifying $2^{\text {nd }}$ condition in the GO(MS) No. 219/2022/RD dated 16.09 .2022 as " the fund for the road construction shall be met by State Government", the Hon'ble Chief Minister has ordered to place the matter before Council of Ministers.

## Point for Decision

Whether the $2^{\text {nd }}$ condition in GO(MS) No.219/2022/RD dated 16/09/2022 as per which permissive sanction has been given for using the land as entry road to National Academy of Indirect Taxes and Narcotics, Zonal Training Institute may be modified as follows;
"The fund for the road construction shall be met by State Government."
