CIRCULAR

Sub: Home Department -Police Establishment - General guidelines based on the recommendations of Justice C.N Ramachandran Nair Commission Report-reg

Ref: D.O Letter No: T9/9846/2018/PHQ, dated 16.02.2021 from the State Police Chief.

Justice C.N. Ramachandran Nair Commission on Police and Prisons Reforms has recommended that the Police officers engaged in investigation of major crimes may not be disturbed through transfers at the fag end of the investigation of the cases unless compelling circumstances are there, because the same will affect early completion of investigation, filing of charge-sheet etc.

The following general instructions are issued regarding the transfer of the Police officers who are engaged in investigation of major crime cases.

- 1. The Police officers engaged in investigation of major crimes should not generally be disturbed through transfers at the fag end of the investigation of the cases. But the same may be resorted under certain special circumstances
- 2. The investigation Officer may continue the investigation of an important case even if he is transferred to another place.
