ORDER

SCOLE - Kerala in collaboration with Kerala State Disaster Management Authority proposes to start a diploma course "Diploma in Disaster Risk Management". The course intends to mainstream the understanding of disaster management and mitigation and the conditions that could lead to disasters by improving capacity of teachers to build awareness on disaster related aspects in students at the school level. The syllabus of the course has been prepared by SCOLE-Kerala as per the guidelines of KSDMA.

Member Secretary, KSDMA has reported that it is proposed to conduct the course in all 14 districts with a pilot course in Thiruvananthapuram District. The proposed duration of the course designed in hybrid mode is 150 hours. The cost of organizing one batch of the course is estimated at Rs.8,40,000/- and the revenue is estimated at Rs.1,50,000/-. Hence the funds required for the course for one batch is Rs.6,90,000/- which is requested to be met from State Disaster Relief Fund (SDRF).

State Executive Committee of KSDMA held on 18/01/2024 has agreed to the proposal to start diploma course "Diploma in Disaster Risk Management".

Government have examined the matter in detail and are pleased to approve the proposal of KSDMA and SCOLE- Kerala for jointly starting a Diploma course in Disaster Risk Management. The pilot course shall be held in

Thiruvananthapuram District. An amount of Rs. 6,90,000/- shall be released to KSDMA for transferring to SCOLE-Kerala from SDRF Head of Account 2245-02-101-94-01-Flood Other items for the conduct of the pilot programme.
