Home Department – Police Department - State Plan Scheme 2022-23 - Logistical Support for Control Rooms for effective Surveillance System in Districts-Purchase of Photostat machine - Revised Administrative Sanction accorded - Orders issued.

ORDER

Under the State Plan Scheme 2022-2023, Administrative sanction was accorded for an amount of Rs.50 lakh towards Enhancing the Law & Order capability of GRP (Railway Police) under the scheme Logistical Support for Control Rooms for effective Surveillance System in Districts as per the Government Order read above. State Police Chief as per letter read above has reported that accordingly fund has been allotted to Superintendent of Police, Railway Police Headquarters under Head of Account "2055-00-115-98-33 Scheme for Logistical Support for Control Rooms" and later Superintendent of Police, Railway Police Headquarters has informed that a contingent bill amounting to Rs.9,09,870/- has been prepared in BIMS vide CB No.211/2022-23 (BRN-22010253000501362108 dated 17.03.2023) for the payment of purchasing Inverter and Batteries from M/s Hykon India Ltd for an amount of Rs. 7,50,480/- and Photostat Machines from M/s Future Eyes Infotech for an amount of Rs. 1,59,390/-. This was submitted to the Principal Sub Treasury Fort, Thiruvananthapuram along with the relevant vouchers for encashment. The same bill was encashed on 20.03.2023 by successfully making the payment only to the M/s Hykon India Ltd for an amount of Rs.7,50,480/-, while an amount of Rs.1,59,390/- due to M/s Future Eyes Infotech has been returned to the Government account despite giving the correct account-details of the

firm. While verifying through BIMS, the payment seems settled. But the payment due to M/s Future Eyes Infotech for an amount of Rs. 1,59,390/- for purchasing Photostat machines is still pending for want of clearance from Government. State Police Chief has therefore requested to give clearance for an amount of Rs.1,59,390/- for making payment to M/s.Future Eyes Infotech, towards the purchase of Photostat machine.

Government have examined the matter in detail and are pleased to accord revised Administrative Sanction for an amount of Rs.1,59,390/- (Rupees One Lakh Fifty Nine Thousand Three Hundred and Ninety Only) for making payment to M/s.Future Eyes Infotech, towards the purchase of Photostat machine from the Head of Account "2055-00-115-98-33 Scheme for Logistical Support for Control Rooms" in the current Financial Year's budget provision.

State Police Chief shall generate a fresh bill for which certificate from the Treasury officer to the effect that an amount of Rs.1,59,390 encashed through the contingent bill No. CB No. 211/2022-23 (BRN-22010253000501362108 dated 17.03.2023) of Rs.9,09,870/- has been returned to the government account.
