<u>ORDER</u>

As per the Government order read above, in-principle sanction was accorded for implementing 'Kerala Health Systems Improvement Program' with a total project cost of Rs.3000 crore with the assistance of the World Bank subject to the condition that the project should be accommodated within the overall normal plan allocation of Health Sector for the entire project implementation period as this has to be accommodated within the borrowing ceiling of each year. Of the total project amount, Rs.2100 crore will be met through financial assistance from World Bank and the balance Rs.900 crore as State share. The project is envisaged to be implemented in all 14 Districts of Kerala with a project duration of 5 years. 2) Subsequent to the meeting held on 29.11.2023 with the officials of World Bank, it is decided to constitute a Core Committee and Committee for Thematic Components comprising of the competent officials from the DHS, DME NHM and Finance Department for guiding both program design and implementation of the project Kerala Health Systems Improvement Programme. Accordingly, nominations have been received as per the letters read as 3rd to 5th and U.O Note read as 6th above.
