ORDER

As per the letter read as 1st above the Director of Fisheries furnished Project Proposal of VIDYATHEERAM – Education and Coaching Programme for a total outlay of Rs. 15.00 Crore and has requested to accord sanction for the same. The expenditure in this regard should be met from the Head of account 2405-00-103-80 (P) 'Basic Infrastructure facilities and Human Development of Fisher folk' in the current year.

2) The project proposal VIDYATHEERAM has been conceptualised to address a few prioritised essential critical gaps from among the majority that may eventually help in realising the goal of bringing the fishing community into the mainstream of the State's educational development and to handhold the children of fishermen to be in par with the general population in competitiveness for gaining employment in professional fields and to come up in life.

The objectives of the project is as follows:

- To provide assistance to 130 nos. of students for medical entrance coaching, 12 nos. of students for civil service exam coaching and 12 nos. of students for NIT/IIT coaching.
- To adopt children of fishermen whose both parents has been deceased. The expenditure in this regard will be fully met by the Government.
- To provide educational assistance to fishermen students for post matric studies.

- To conduct 10 nos. of career guidance programme to students who are studying in 10th and 12th classes.
- To provide operational expenses to the 10 Government Regional Fisheries Technical High Schools (GRFTHS) by providing all the essential items such as mess, hostel facilities etc. for the fishermen students.
- To provide latest infrastructural facilities in the 10 GRFTHS as smart class rooms, equipping libraries, sports grounds and thus bringing up the schools as 'Centre of Excellence'.
- To promote sports activities in the Government Schools where the children of Fishermen are predominant.
- Skill development through ASAP and KDisc.
- IEC activities.
