ORDER

An amount of Rs.30 crore is provided as Plan fund in the annual budget (FY 2023-24) under the Head of Account '2210-01-001-88(P)' for the implementation of the scheme - 'Kerala Digital Health Mission - e Health Programme'. Out of the budget allocation, a total amount of Rs.21,16,64,150/- was released, as per Government Orders read as paper 1st to 4th above.

- **2.** The Additional Project Director, e Health Kerala, as per the letter read as paper 5th above, submitted a proposal for Administrative Sanction for Rs.8,83,35,000/-, f or implementing the Scheme 'Kerala Digital Health Mission e Health Programme'. The Special Working Group meeting held on 13.03.2024 approved the proposal as per the minutes read as 6th above.
- 3. Government have examined the matter in detail. In pursuance of the decision of Special Working Group, Administrative Sanction is accorded for an amount of Rs.8,83,35,000/- (Rupees Eight Crore Eighty Three Lakh and Thirty Five Thousand Only), under the

Head of Account $^{\prime}2210\text{-}01\text{-}001\text{-}88(P)^{\prime}$ for implementation of the Scheme 'Kerala Digital Health Mission - e Health Programme , as follows:

VIII. Overhead Charges

To meet the expense of non-technical staff, Office expenses like Electricity, Water, Telephone, Internet, Fuel, Hiring of vehicles, Stationary etc, an amount of Rs.68,14,000/- (equivalent to 10% of the institution functional cost) is allocated.

IX. Retention and Yearly Support Charges

An amount of Rs.30,00,000/- is allotted to meet the expenditure towards 'Retention and Yearly Support Charge' during the Annual Plan Period of 2023-24.

X. Recurring Primary & Secondary Connectivity Charge

An amount of Rs.17,43,000/- is alloted for recurring secondary charge of functionalised 469 e Health institutions during the Annual Plan Period of 2023-24.

4. The fund release will be based on actual requirement and the fund released should not be parked in banks. Store Purchase Rules shall be strictly adhered to. Tender / e-Tender and other stipulated formalities shall be followed wherever necessary. Creation of posts and purchase of Vehicles are not admissible under the Scheme. For hiring of project staff / man power as a part of project implementation, instructions issued in G.O.(P)No.76/2019/Fin dated 02.07.2019 and G.O. (P)No.81/2019/Fin dated 09.07.2019 shall be followed. The Project Director, e Health Kerala should monitor the the progress of implementation of the Scheme and ensure its timely completion.
