No.6/2024/F&P dated 05/01/2024 is revised for the installation of 6000 transponders in marine fishing vessels in Kerala as part of National Rollout plan for installation of vessel communication and support system in marine fishing vessels for Monitoring, Control and Surveillance (MCS) with state share of Rs. 9,06,62,333.3 /- . The action taken by the Director of Fisheries to remit the state share of Rs. 2.2665583 Cr (25% of Rs. 9,06,62,333.3/-) to the a/c of M/s. NSIL is also ratified.
