Power Department – Construction of 33 kV Substation at Pinnakkanadu in Kottayam District – Administrative Sanction accorded–Orders issued.

ORDER

As per letter read 6th above, the Kerala State Electricity Board reported that as per Board order read as 2nd paper above, Administrative Sanction was accorded for the Construction of a 33 kV Substation at Pinnakkanadu in Kottayam District including 33 kV lines from 110 kV substation, Erattupetta and 33 kV substation, Paika to Pinnakkanadu at an estimated cost of Rs.14.63 crore. Out of the total Administrative Sanction amount, an amount of Rs.97.25 lakh was earmarked for the purchase of land for the substation.

2. It is also reported that sanction was accorded for purchasing 35 cents of land in resurvey No. 282/9 of Kondoor Village as per Board

Order read as 3rd paper above. Even though sanction was accorded as per the G.O read as 4th paper above for the acquisition of the land, the same could not be materialized since the owner of the said land sold the land to another person. Hence, after exploring various alternative locations, 21 cents of land in Survey No. 282/9-3 in Kondoor Village, Meenachil Taluk owned by Sri. Issac Nirappel, Thidanadu, Chemmalamattom P.O, has been identified for constructing the substation and KSEBL accorded sanction as per Board Order read as 5th above for acquiring this land through LARR Act 2013. In this Board Order it has been stated that the financial commitment will be Rs.59.85lakh (approximate).

3. Since, Administrative Sanction from the Administrative Department concerned is mandatory for the procurement of land as per the provisions contained in the Government order read as 1st paper above, KSEBL as per letter read as 6th above has requested the Government to accord revised Administrative Sanction for the project.

4. Government have examined the matter in detail and are pleased to accord administrative sanction for the construction of 33 kV Substation at Pinnakkanadu in Kottayam district at an estimated cost of Rs.14.63 crore.

5. The entire expenditure for the project will be met from the own funds of Kerala State Electricity Board Limited.
