ORDER

As per the Government Order read above Administrative Sanction was accorded for implementing Kannur City Road improvement Project (KACRIP) on a DBFOT- hybrid Annuity mode without tolling at an estimated cost of Rs.401.467 crores and to meet the expenses in connection with the initial payment as well as the annuity payment to the Concessionaire from the funds vested with KRFB.

2. Subsequently in the meeting chaired by the Hon'ble Chief Minister on 10.08.2021 it had been resolved to bifurcate the Kannur CRIP into three phases, viz: Phase 1 - Three Corridors (C-09- Inner Ring Road,C-10-Pattalam Road,C-11-Jail Road), Phase II (C-01- Manna Junction New NH Bypass,C-03-Podikundu - Kottooli Road,C-08- Thayyil - Thezhukkila Peedika, C-12-Kunjipalli - Pulluppi Road) & Phase III - (C-02-Chalad - Kunjipalli Road, C-04-Mini Bypass Road, C-05-Kakkad - Mundayad Road, C-07-Plaza Junction - JTS Road).

3. As per the letter read above, the CEO KRFB submitted a revalidated DPR of Phase I corridor of KACRIP by PWD Design Wing which amounts to RS. 16,15,00,000/ (inclusive of Miscellaneous including Reconstruction of road with median footpath, landscaping, table top pedestrian crossing, utility shifting,

dewatering underpass , traffic signal etc.) and a Bid Document & Concession Agreement prepared by the Transaction Advisor for the approval of Government. The CEO, KRFB also requested to accord sanction to initiate the tendering process for the Phase I of KACRIP, in selecting the Concessionaire for implementing the Project -Phase 1 on DBFOT Annuity mode.

4. Government have examined the matter in detail and are pleased to accord sanction for the implementation of Phase-I of Kannur City Improvement Project for an amount of ₹ 16.15 crore through KRFB and arrange the same through item rate contract to avoid charging of comparatively high fixed overhead charges for 15 years on account of establishment cost of Concessionaire and Independent Engineer (OH charges) repeatedly in each phase and for getting a more competitive offer.
