ORDER

As per the Government order read as 1st paper above, Administrative Sanction was accorded for implementation of various projects under NABARD - RIDF Tranche XXIX and final Sanction for these projects were issued by NABARD vide letter read 2nd above.

Among the sanctioned projects, the project Construction of Hanging Solar Power Fencing in Chalakudy, Vazhachal and Malayattoor Division in Thirssur and Ernakulam District for a total financial outlay of Rs. 1344.69 Lakhs are proposed to be executed through Kerala Police Housing Construction Corporation, which is an accredited Government agency for execution of public works.

As the work costs more than 5 crore, a Technical sanction for the

project for a total financial outlay of Rs. 1344.69 lakhs to be executed through KPHCC was accorded as per the Government order read 4th above, after the scrutiny of the Technical Sanction Committee constituted vide Government order read as 3rd above.

Now it is reported as per the letter read as 6th paper above that MoU was executed with KPHCC for the execution of the above project. Even though tender was invited by KPHCC, for the execution of the project there was no response for the tender. Considering the urgency of the matter, KPHCC has submitted separate estimates for the Forest Divisions viz; Chalakkudy, Vazhachal and Malayattoor as follows:

In the guidelines issued by Finance Department as per the Government order read as 5th paper above, regarding selection of accredited agencies for execution of public works stipulated that for works costing more than Rs. 5 Crore, Technical Sanction should be given by Technical Sanction Committee chaired by the Secretary of Administrative Department and comprising of two serving engineers not below the rank of Executive Engineer from Government Department and a Chief Engineer from the accredited agency. In case of non availability of four serving engineers, one serving engineer can be substituted with retired engineer not below the rank of Executive Engineer. The services of retired engineer to assist the Committee could be engaged for helping the Government Technical Sanction Committee in scrutinizing the estimate and liaison with the accredited agency. The remuneration paid for such engineer shall be @ Rs.35,000/- for each work or 0.1% of the project cost whichever is lower as per G.O (P) No 67/2021/Fin dated 28-04-2021.

The previously mentioned projects include the following work with estimated cost exceeding Rupees Five Crores.

1. Construction of Hanging Solar Power Fencing in Vazhachal (60 km) with an estimated cost of Rs.7,47,06.000/- (Rupees Seven Crore Forty Seven Lakh and Six Thousand only).

In the circumstances, Government are pleased to constitute technical sanction committee for the project; Construction of Hanging Solar Power Fencing in Vazhachal with following members so as to facilitate execution of work through Kerala Police Housing Construction Corporation;
