ORDER

WHEREAS, it has been disclosed from the records of investigation in Crime No.834/2024 of Karipur Police Station that the accused Mohammed Siraj P V, S/o Kunhayin P V, Puthan Veetil, Kodakkad, Ariyallur, Malappuram, had fraudulently obtained Indian Passport bearing No. F 1735622 under the name and address of Mohamed Rafi, S/o Kunhayi, No.70/2, Old Pension Mohalla, Mysore Road Cross, Bangalore from Passport office Bangalore. Subsequently, he renewed the said passport as M 3437651 from Kuwait. On 16.10.2024, the accused Mohammed Siraj P V arrived at Calicut International Airport from Kuwait by Flight No.IX-394/KWI and approached the Immigration Counter for clearance, producing Emergency Certificate No. X 1059007, issued from Kuwait. Upon verification, it was revealed that, the passenger details such as name, date of birth, address and father's name in Passport & Emergency Certificate were all different with the details in his Extract of the School Admission Register, Adhar Card and SSLC Certificate. Thus the accused Mohammed Siraj P V violated Passport Act and Rules and committed offences punishable under section 336(3), 340(2), 319(2) of Bharatiya Nyaya Sanhita, 2023 and section 12(1)(a) & 12(1)(b) of the Indian Passport Act, 1967.

AND WHEREAS, the Government of Kerala after careful examination of the records of investigation in Crime No.834/2024 of Karipur Police Station are fully satisfied that the aforesaid accused Mohammed Siraj P V committed offences punishable under section 12(1)(a) and 12(1)(b) of the

Passport Act, 1967 along with other offences for which he should be prosecuted.

NOW THEREFORE, Government of Kerala, in exercise of the powers conferred by section 15 of the Passports Act, 1967 read with Government of India Notification No. GSR 662(E), dated 01.12.1979 of the Ministry of External Affairs do hereby, accord sanction to prosecute the accused Mohammed Siraj P V, for the offences punishable under section 12(1)(a) and 12(1)(b) of the Passport Act, 1967, in Crime No.834/2024 of Karipur Police Station and for taking cognizance of the said offences by a court of competent jurisdiction.
