### ORDER

The petitioners in WP(C) No 25383/2025 are the former students of Kannur Medical College ,Anjarakkandy which was closed down pursuant to the proceedings issued by the Hon'ble Supreme Court in SLP(C) No.23225 of 2018. The petitioners were successfully completed the MBBS Course from the Kannur Medical College ,Anjarakkandy and transferred to various Government Hospitals for CRMI as per the judgment dated 10.06.2022 of Hon'ble High Court in WP(C) No.16511/2022. The Prayer of the petitioners is to direct the respondents to pay monthly stipend to the petitioners with arrears from the date of commencement of their Compulsory Rotatory Medical Internship (CRRI). As per the Interim Order read as 6th paper above , the Hon'ble High Court directed to disburse 50% of the stipend due to the petitioners within a period of one month and the balance amount should be paid within a further period of one month in view of judgment

dated 09.09.2024 in WP(C) No.30722/2024.

2) Government have examined the matter in detail . As per the GOs read as 1st and 2nd papers above, sanction was already accorded for the disbursement of stipends to the former students of Kannur Medical College Anjarakandy who had completed their internships in various self-financing medical colleges in compliance with the directions issued by the Hon'ble High Court in several Writ Petitions.

3) Subsequently, as per the GOs read as 4th and 5th paper above .sanction was also accorded for the disbursement of stipend to the former students of Kannur Medical College ,Anjarakandy who had completed their internships in various Government Hospitals in compliance with the judgment dated 02.04.2025 of Hon'ble High Court in WP(C) No. 5547/2023.

4) In the circumstances Government are pleased to accord sanction to the Director of Medical Education for disbursement of stipend to Dr. Bazil Mohammed S, Dr. Kiran Raj, Dr. Faizal A, and Dr. Santhosh Kumar Kriparam, petitioners in WP(C) No. 25383/2025 from the fund authorized under the head of account "2210-05-105-80-12-Non plan charged" as per the GO read as 7th paper above.

5) The DME will also take necessary steps to regularize the additional expenditure through re-appropriation of savings within the Grant /Supplementary Demands for Grants before the close of the current financial year it self.

6) The Interim Order dated 25.07.2025 of Hon'ble High Court in WP(C) No. 25383/2025 filed by Dr. Bazil Mohammed S and others complied with accordingly .
