### ORDER

As per G.O.s read as 1<sup>st</sup>, 2<sup>nd</sup>, 3<sup>rd</sup> and 4<sup>th</sup> papers above, Administrative Sanction has been issued for three projects submitted by the Kerala State Electricity Board Ltd. (KSEB) under the Power Department at an estimated cost of ₹53.55 crore as given below:

- i. Upgradation of existing 66kV substation at Kuttanad with 2x10MVA capacity to 110kV substation with 2x12.5MVA capacity in elevated design- ₹19.25 crore.*
- ii. Construction of a new 110kV substation at Kavalam with 2x12.5MVA capacity in elevated design- ₹20.50 crore; and*
- iii. Construction of a new 33kV substation at Kidangara with 2x5MVA capacity in elevated design- ₹13.80 crore.*

2. The financial year utilization of fund for the KSEB projects under RKI is extracted below:

3. As per G.O. read as 5<sup>th</sup> paper above, an amount of ₹3,36,56,002/- has been transfer credited to the PSTSB of KSEB in the current F.Y.

4. As per Letter read as 6<sup>th</sup> paper above, the KSEB has requested to disburse a total amount of ₹2,85,84,915/- including ₹54,99,665/- which was already expended from KSEB's own fund for RKI projects.

5. The Government have examined the matter in detail, and are pleased to accord sanction to allot a total amount to the tune of **₹2,30,85,250/- (Rupees Two crore Thirty lakh Eighty-five thousand Two hundred and Fifty only)** as 7<sup>th</sup> installment towards the implementation of the KSEB projects under the RKI. Sanction is also accorded to transfer-credit the fund to the PSTSB account KSEB maintained at District Treasury, Alappuzha (Account No. 799012700002257) through the DDO of the RKI (Code: 011167D084). The RKI shall make appropriate allocation through BaMS by debiting the amount to the heads of account 5475-00-115-94 (04) *Public buildings-Major repairs and reconstruction (RKI)*.

6. The KSEB Ltd. shall submit the Utilization Certificate for the sanctioned amount.
