## **ORDER**

As per Government Order read as 1<sup>st</sup> paper above, Administrative Sanction was accorded for the work - Construction of 200 Bedded Cardiology Block at Government Medical College, Kottayam for an amount of Rs.3641.81 Lakh with NABARD loan assistance of Rs.3095.96 Lakh. The PMC for the said work is M/s HITES and the work is currently ongoing and the funds are sanctioned for the said project in a reimbursement manner. Accordingly the reimbursement claim for the works done in November 2024 (RAB 20) with respect to the project, for an amount of Rs.Rs.2,12,41,000/- was sanctioned under the head of account '4210-03-105-12(01)(PV)', vide Government Order read as 2<sup>nd</sup> paper above.

**2.** As per the letter read as 3<sup>rd</sup> paper above, the Director of Medical Education (DME) has now informed that since the funds were sanctioned as per Government Order read as paper 2<sup>nd</sup> above in the fag end of the Financial year, even though the bills were processed and sent

> to WAMS, clearance was not received in the FY 2024-25 and hence the funds could not be utilized. The DME has furthermore informed that the works of the Cardiology Block was started in the second half of 2022 and the completion period was 18 months, however the project is still not completed due to the huge gap in the payment releases which ultimately resulted in the delay of commission of project. In the circumstances, DME has requested to take suitable steps to avoid the payment delay and to reallot the amount of Rs.2,12,41,000/- sanctioned as per Government Order read as paper 2<sup>nd</sup> above, for releasing the same to the contractor for the civil works pertaining to the construction of 200 Bedded Cardiology Block at GMC, Kottayam.

- 3. Government have examined the matter in detail. Accordingly sanction is hereby accorded to release Rs.2,12,41,000/- (Rupees Two Crore Twelve Lakh and Forty One Thousand Only) under the head of account '4210-03-105-12(01)(PV) - Infrastructure Projects Under NABARD' to the Director of Medical Education on account of Reimbursement Claim of the cost of work done in November 2024 -Civil works (RAB 20), for the project 'Construction of 200 Bedded Cardiology Block at Government Medical College, Kottayam', by revalidating the Government Order read as 2<sup>nd</sup> paper above. The sanctioned amount is additionally authorized vide Government Order read as 4<sup>th</sup> paper above.
- 4. The Director of Medical Education should ensure the eligibility and accuracy of the claim before the release of funds and should also take timely steps to regularize the expenditure through re-appropriation.
- 5. The Government Order read as 2<sup>nd</sup> paper above stands revalidated to the above extent only.
