ORDER

As per the Government Order read as Paper 2nd above Administrative Sanction was accorded for the work "Budget 2022-23 Improvements to Perambra - Chembra -Koorachund road between km 2/200 to 4/700" for ₹ 400 lakh. Whereas another work was going on the same road (Perambra - Chembra -Koorachund Km 2/200 to 4/700) for an amount of ₹ 375 lakh, for which Administrative Sanction was granted vide the government order read as first paper above.

2. The Chief Engineer, as per the letter read as Paper 3rd above, has requested government to substitute the work "Budget 2022-23 Improvements to Perambra - Chembra -Koorachund road between km 2/200 to 4/700" with the work "Improvement to Meppayyur-Cheruvannur-Pannimukku- Avala

and approach to Gulikapuzha bridge road-b/w KM 0/000-4/000 and 6/500-9/400" and to accord Administrative Sanction for the work for ₹1000 lakh under the h/a '5054-04-337-99'.

3. Government have examined the matter in detail and are pleased to accord Administrative Sanction for the work "Improvement to Meppayyur-Cheruvannur- Pannimukku- Avala and approach to Gulikapuzha bridge road between KM 0/000 - 4/000 and 6/500 - 9/400 - General Civil Work" for an amount of ₹10 Crore (Rupees Ten Crore Only) under the h/a "5054-04-337-99-MDR" subject to the compliance of following conditions while issuing the Technical Sanction:-

i. Necessity of scarification proposed for the entire road reach shall be confirmed by the Chief Engineer after a site visit in person by the CE / SE.

ii. The scarified materials shall be utilized for filling below the Granular Sub Base (GSB) layer or at shoulders with proper compaction."
