## **ORDER**

As per the 1 st paper above, Managing Director, Kerala Water Authority informed that Kerala Road Fund Board has demanded ₹3,45,56,326/- as road restoration charge for granting permission for laying pipelines along the Meppadi-Chooralmala Road under the Jal Jeevan Mission project. The above payment could not be effected at present due to the paucity of state share under JJM. The pipeline needs to be lain before KRFB starts the road work. This pipe line is for supplying drinking water to 8 to 14 wards of Meppadi Grama Panchayath including Churalmala-Mundakkayam area. He has also requested to consider the possibility of remitting the above amount to KRFB as a special package from the Chooralmala rehabilitation projects.

Government have examined the matter in detail and are pleased to release an amount of Rs.3,45,56,326/- to MD, Kerala Water Authority for meeting the expenditure in connection with the road restoration charge for granting permission for laying pipelines along the Meppadi-Chooralmala Road under the Jal Jeevan Mission project from the untied Rs.120 Crore allocated from SDRF as per the GO read as 4<sup>th</sup> paper above. Member Secretary, Kerala State Disaster Management Authority shall be take necessary steps to release the above mentioned amount to Kerala Water Authority.
