Abstract

Home Department - Police Department - Implementation of DMR Tier II Wireless Communication System- Payment of spectrum charge - Ratified - Orders issued.

ORDER

Government have accorded administrative sanction for the Digitization of Wireless Communication (DMR Tier II) in 5 Districts under the ASUMP 2025-26 (State Share) for an amount of Rs.2350 Lakh, as per Government Order read as 1st paper above.

2) The State Police Chief, as per letter read as 2nd paper above, has reported that, work order has been issued to M/s.Sheetal Wireless Technology Pvt. Ltd. for Digitization (Implementation of DMR Tier II) of wireless communication system at Northern Cluster (Palakkad and Malappuram) and to M/s.Arya Communications Electronics Services Pvt. Ltd for Digitization (Implementation of DMR Tier II) of wireless communication system at Southern cluster (Thiruvananthapuram Rural, Kollam City, Kollam Rural), after following due procedural formalities.

3) The State Police Chief has further reported that, to ensure the operational readiness of the network, a Wireless Operational License

(WOL) is essential and the Wireless Planning & Coordination (WPC) Wing, New Delhi, issued a Letter of Intent (LOI) for frequency assignment, which stipulated a spectrum charge payment of Rs.4,05,37,000/-. The Decision Letter (DL) to grant a license can be obtained only after the payment of the said spectrum charge within sixty days from the date of issuance of LOI.

4) The State Police Chief has also reported that it was further observed that the Kerala Police maintained an excess balance of Rs.12,10,15,633/- with the WPC Wing. The said balance amount was utilized to settle all current spectrum charges for DLs and WOLs up to March 31, 2026. Following these adjustments, a remaining excess balance of Rs.9,37,75,783/- was available with the WPC Wing. Given the urgency of making the network operational and the fact that the WPC Wing does not provide refunds but allows adjustments for future network charges, the State Police Chief authorized the SP (Telecommunication & Technology) to remit the required spectrum charge of Rs.4,05,37,000/- by adjusting it against the excess balance available with WPC Wing. The State Police Chief has requested to ratify the above action.

5) Government have examined the matter in detail and are pleased to ratify the action of the State Police Chief in having remitted the spectrum charge of Rs.4,05,37,000/- (Rupees Four Crore Five Lakh and Thirty Seven Thousand Only) through adjustment of the excess balance available with the WPC Wing, New Delhi, without obtaining prior approval of Government, considering the urgency and the procedural necessity of the project 'Implementation of DMR Tier II Wireless Communication System' in 5 districts, under the ASUMP 2025-2026 Scheme.
