ORDER

Government of India, as per letter read as 1st paper above, allocated central financial assistance of Rs.50,00,00,000/-(Rupees Fifty Crore only) to the Government of Kerala during the financial year 2025-26 for development of fisheries in the State under the Pradhan Mantri Matsya Sampada Yojana (PMMSY).

2. The Director of Fisheries, as per letter read as 2nd paper above, informed that since the central fund allotted is Rs.50 crore, the corresponding state share will be Rs.33.333 crore, thus total an amount of Rs.83.333 crore needs to be sanctioned for the time bound and smooth implementation of the project under PMMSY. Hence the fund allocation required in the SPARSH account for the implementation of the ongoing schemes of PMMSY are as follows:-

The Director of Fisheries, as per letter read as 2nd paper above, also reported that the bills for SNA SPARSH are to be prepared in a single budget line so as to suit the new work flow of IFMS - RBI- ekuber -PFMS integration and to follow the above system in the current financial year, the bills for SNA SPARSH may be prepared only through State head of accounts (02 Heads) of corresponding SLS for schemes having both Central and State share. In the above circumstances, Director of Fisheries requested to accord sanction for additional authorization of an amount of Rs.38.333 crore and re-appropriation of fund from the 01 plan heads to 02 plan heads under the head(s) of account as detailed in above table and utilization of Rs.83.333 crore for the implementation of the PMMSY scheme through SNA SPARSH.

4. Government have examined the matter in detail and are pleased to accord sanction for additional authorization of an amount of **Rs.38.333 crore (Rupees Thirty Eight Crore Thirty Three Lakh Thirty Thousand Only)** and re-appropriation of a sum of **Rs.27 Crore (Rupees Twenty Seven Crore Only)** under the head(s) of account as detailed in above table, as per Government Order read as 3rd and 4th paper above respectively and utilization of **Rs.83.333 crore (Rupees Eighty three crore thirty three lakh and thirty thousand only)** for the implementation of the PMMSY scheme through SNA SPARSH.

5. The Director of Fisheries will take timely steps to regularise this additional expenditure through Reappropriation of Savings within the Grant/Supplementary Demands for Grants before the close of the current financial year.
