ORDER

As per the Government Order read as 1st paper above, the industrial dispute between the Managing Director Lunar Rubbers (P) Ltd and its workmen was referred for adjudication to the Labour Court, Ernakulam.

2) The Hon'ble High Court of Kerala, as per the judgment read as 2nd paper above, observed that the issues framed in the original reference were not in accordance with the actual dispute. Accordingly, the Court directed the Government to reconsider the matter and issue a fresh reference order with corrected issues. In view of the High Court judgment and the return of the reference from the Labour Court as per the letter read as 3rd paper above, and based on the report of the Labour Commissioner read as 4th paper above, Government have examined the matter in detail. And Government are now pleased to cancel the G.O.(Rt) No. 1165/2016/LBR. dated 19.09.2016 .

3) Whereas, the Government are of opinion that an industrial dispute exists between the Managing Director, Lunar Rubbers, Olamattom, Thodupuzha- 685 584 and the workmen of the above referred establishment represented by the Secretary, Kerala Headload and Timber Workers & Factory Workers Union (KTUC), Thodupuzha -685 581 in respect of matters mentioned in the annexure to this order;

4) And whereas, in the opinion of Government it is necessary to refer the said industrial dispute for adjudication;

5) Now, therefore, in exercise of the powers conferred by Section 10(1) (d) of the Industrial Disputes Act of 1947 (Central Act XIV of 1947) the Government hereby direct that the said industrial dispute be referred for adjudication to the Industrial Tribunal, Peermade, Idukki. The Industrial Tribunal will pass the award within a period of three months.

6) This order is issued in full compliance with the judgment of the Hon'ble High Court of Kerala dated 30/01/2026 in WP(C)1003/2020.
