ORDER

As per Government Order read as 1st paper above, Administrative Sanction was accorded for an amount of ₹.3641.84 lakh for the project 'Construction of 200 Bedded Cardiology Block at Government Medical College, Kottayam' under Tranche XXVI of NABARD RIDF scheme (NABARD share ₹.3095.56 lakh, State share 546.28 lakh). As per Government Order read as 2nd paper above, M/s. HITES was entrusted as the SPV for the project. As per Government Order read as 3rd paper above, Technical Sanction was issued for the above project for an amount of ₹.3025.66386 lakh.

2. Till now Reimbursement Claims upto RAB 21 had been released to the Director of Medical Education as the cost of work done for the project 'Construction of 200 Bedded Cardiology Block at Government Medical College, Kottayam', vide various Government Orders. As per

the Government Order read as 4th paper above, an amount of ₹23,12,659/- (Rupees Twenty Three Lakh Twelve Thousand Six Hundred and Fifty Nine Only) was also released to the Director of Medical Education on account of Reimbursement Claim for the cost of work done in April 2025 with regard to SITC of MGPS (RAB 01), for the project.

3. As per letter read as 5th paper above the Director of Medical Education (DME) submitted the Reimbursement Claim of RAB 22 & Part for the Civil works and for the SITC of MGPS (RAB 02), in respect of the project - Construction of 200 Bedded Cardiology Block at Government Medical College, Kottayam and requested to release the reimbursement claimed.

4. Government have examined the matter in detail. Accordingly, sanction is hereby accorded to release **Rs.145.07 lakh (Rupees One Crore Forty Five Lakh and Seven Thousand only)** to the Director of Medical Education under the head of account '**4210-03-105-12-01 -PV - Infrastructure Projects Under NABARD**', on account of Reimbursement claim of RAB 22 & Part for the Civil works and the SITC of MGPS (RAB 02) pertaining to the NABARD RIDF Tranche XXVI project - Construction of 200 Bedded Cardiology Block at Government Medical College, Kottayam, as detailed below:
