ORDER

WHEREAS, it has been disclosed from the records of investigation in Crime No.193/2024 of Nedumbassery Police Station that the accused [A1] Sakkeena Mustafa, W/o Mustafa Palakkal Moidu, Palakkal House, Koorachundu P O, Kozhikode, approached the departure immigration at Cochin International Airport on 14.02.2024 intending to travel to Kuwait Via Muscat by flight no. 6E-057. On verification of her travel documents, it was revealed that her passport No. P 8100289 was tampered by concealing the Kuwait employment stamp visa which is valid from 04.01.2024 to 29.03.2024 affixed in page number 5 by pasting a Saudi Arabian Sticker Visa with the help of the accused [A2] Azeez Palakkavalappil, S/o Yahu, Palakkavalappil House, C.V.Jn, Behind Canara Bank, Ponnani, Malappuram. Thus the accused [A1] Sakkeena Mustafa violated Passport Act and Rules and committed offences punishable under section 465, 468 & 471 of Indian Penal Code, 1860 and section 12(1)(a) & 12(1)(b) of the Indian Passport Act, 1967 and the accused [A2] Azeez Palakkavalappil committed offences punishable under section 465, 468 & 471 of Indian Penal Code, 1860 and section 12(2) of the Indian Passport Act, 1967.

AND WHEREAS, the Government of Kerala after careful examination of the records of investigation in Crime No.193/2024 of Nedumbassery Police Station are fully satisfied that the aforesaid accused [A1] Sakkeena Mustafa committed offences punishable under section 12(1)(a) and 12(1)(b)

of the Passport Act, 1967 and the accused [A2] Azeez Palakkavalappil committed offences punishable under section 12(2) of the Passport Act, 1967 along with other offences for which they should be prosecuted.

NOW THEREFORE, Government of Kerala, in exercise of the powers conferred by section 15 of the Passports Act, 1967 read with Government of India Notification No. GSR 662(E), dated 01.12.1979 of the Ministry of External Affairs do hereby, accord sanction to prosecute the accused [A1] Sakkeena Mustafa, for the offences punishable under section 12(1)(a) and 12(1)(b) of the Passport Act, 1967 and the accused [A2] Azeez Palakkavalappil, for the offences punishable under section 12(2) of the Passport Act, 1967, in Crime No.193/2024 of Nedumbassery Police Station and for taking cognizance of the said offences by a court of competent jurisdiction.
