Home Department - Police Department - Entrusting the remaining works of State Police Museum to Kerala Police Housing and Construction Corporation Ltd.- Revised Administrative Sanction accorded - Orders issued.

ORDER

As per the GO read as 1st paper above administrative sanction was accorded for the construction of the State Police Museum at Police Training College, Thiruvananthapuram for an amount of Rs. 104.460 Lakh and Rs. 25 Lakhs were allotted for the initiation of the work in the same year. Later as per the GO read as 2nd paper above Government issued revised administrative sanction for an amount of Rs. 106.90,401 Lakhs by meeting the expenditure under the head of account 4055-00-207-92-27.

- 2) As per the letter read as 3rd paper above, the State Police Chief has

requested to ratify the action of issuing a Work Order to M/s. Habitat Technologies group vide PHQ work order no. H11-18437/2021/PHQ dated 03.02.2021 for an amount of Rs. 2.58 Crores for the construction of the State Police Museum without having sanction from the Government, under the State Plan Scheme 2021-22 and the mobilization advance released to M/s. Habitat Technologies .

3) The State Police Chief has issued the work order to M/s. Habitat Technologies group for an amount of Rs. 258 Lakhs without having sanction from the Government, he was directed to ascertain the details of work order given on the basis of the administrative sanction given vide GO read as 1st paper above. Although a report was furnished by the State Police Chief as per the letter read as 4th paper above was not satisfactory.

4) Accordingly, a meeting was conducted by the then Hon'ble Chief Minister on 10.04.2025 with the Additional Chief Secretary (Home & Vigilance), State Police Chief, Secretary, Finance Department in which it was decided to entrust Finance (Inspection) Wing to conduct detailed inspection in this irregularities, so as to take appropriate action against the officials responsible for the irregularities and also to issue permission to the Kerala Police Housing and Construction Corporation Ltd. (KPHCC) to take over the further works and to complete it without causing any delay.

5) As per the decisions taken in the meeting held by the then Hon'ble Chief Minister, the State Police Chief as per the letter read as 6th paper above has submitted a revised proposal and has requested to accord revised administrative sanction for an amount of Rs. 1,27,80,000/- for entrusting the remaining works of State Police Museum to Kerala Police Housing and Construction Corporation Ltd. (KPHCC). Estimate obtained from Kerala Police Housing and Construction Corporation Ltd. (KPHCC) for the

remaining work of State Police Museum prepared through DSR 2021 was Rs. 1,27,80,000/- (Amount for civil work - Rs. 1,01,60,000/- & Amount for electrical works - Rs. 26,20,000/-)

6) Government have examined the matter in detail and are pleased to accord revised administrative sanction for an amount of Rs. 1,27,80,000/- (Rupees One Crore Twenty Seven Lakhs and Eighty Thousand Only) for entrusting the remaining works of State Police Museum to Kerala Police Housing and Construction Corporation Ltd. (KPHCC).

7) The matter of ratification of the work done by M/s. Habitat Technologies group will be considered only after examining the case with reference to the report of the Finance Inspection Wing in which sanction were accorded from Police Headquarters for the construction State Police Museum to Kerala Police without approval of Government and taking appropriate action against officers responsible for the irregular action.
