ORDER

As per the Government order read from 1 to 7 above administrative sanction for an amount of Rs.100.56 crores was issued and as per 8th paper above, the Chief Executive Officer, KIIFB had been directed to

allocate ₹110 crore, in addition to the ₹ 100 crore sanctioned by KIIFB, for measures related to mitigate human-wildlife conflict. As per the letter read as 9th paper above, a comprehensive proposal/Master plan has been submitted by the Additional Principal Chief Conservator of Forests(E&TW) for the purpose.

2.As per the minutes of the meeting, read as 10th paper above, has decided to implement the said project to mitigate man-animal conflict with 6 components at an estimated cost of Rs 110 Crores using KIIFB funds. Accordingly, as per the letter read as 12th paper above, a project proposal of worth Rs.110 Crores detailing the 6 components indicated below has been submitted for granting administrative sanction.
