### ORDER

M/s Punnamoodu Handloom Weavers Co-operative Society Limited No. H.179, Thiruvananthapuram is registered under the Kerala Co- operative Societies Act, 1969 with General Manager, District Industries Centre, Thiruvananthapuram as its Registrar.

2) M/s Punnamoodu Handloom Weaver's Co-operative Society Ltd had filed writ petitions 7832/2017, 12960/2017 & 22113/2017 before the Hon'ble High Court of Kerala against the non disbursement of handloom rebate sale claims for the period 01.10.2007 to 14.11.2007 & 06.12.2007 to 31.12.2007 and to quash the Government Order G.O(Rt)No.1287/2016/ID dated 07.12.2016. The Hon'ble High Court while disposing all these cases had pronounced a common judgement on 21.01.2020 in WP (C) No. 22113/2017, 7832/2017 and 12960/2017.

3) Hon'ble High Court vide Common Judgment referred above has allowed the petition in WP(C)No.22113/2017 by directing Government to accord sanction to the society to sell its 15 cent of land comprised in Sy.No.428/8 in Kalliyoor for the pupose of enabling the petitioner to effect the sale based on the approval already granted to the said proposal by the General Body of shareholders. The direction of the Hon'ble Court in the said WP(C) has complied vide reference(2) above.

4) In WP(C) 7832/2017 the Hon'ble High Court directed Government to reconsider the matter and pass fresh orders, after hearing the petitioner.

5)In WP(C) 12960/2017, the judgement of the Hon'ble High Court was to consider and pass orders on representation dated 03.11.2016 submitted by the petitioner Society before Government taking note of Exbt P3, ie, Proceedings No.HL/F2392/11(1) dated 17.01.2015 of Director of Handloom & Textiles.

6)On the basis of the Judgment referred above a personal hearing was scheduled on 06.10.2020, for complying directions w.r.to WP(C)7832/2017 and

WP(C) 12960/2017. But the petitioner had not attended the hearing due to the prevailed covid-19 situations then. Later the personal hearing was rescheduled to 14.01.2021. On basis of the request of the petitioner, the hearing was again postponed to 28.01.2021. Finally the petitioner and concerned were heard on the same day.

7) Since the claim is related to many years back, the complete details / issues have not been revealed in the hearing, Government recommended an appropriate level enquiry by Vigilance and Anti-corruption Bureau. Therefore matter has been recommended to Vigilance Department for further action.

8) The direction of the Hon'ble High Court in the Common Judgement read above has thus been complied with.
